

From The Pastor's Desk: Past or Future?

Recently, I watched an interview of a retired NFL, Hall of Fame player. The last question he was asked was, "If you were to live another life, would you choose to live your life from the past, or your life from the future?" The retired player said he'd prefer to live his life from his future. He believed his future was something he could look forward to rather than living his life again and having to endure what he experienced again.

Some may say that from this point in their lives they have nothing to look forward to so by living their life again they knew there'd be wonderful experiences and discoveries coming to them all over again. That's fair, but that's not how we've been made.

I read from Psalm 116 recently: "I called on the name of the LORD: 'O LORD, I pray, I save my life!' Gracious is the LORD, and righteous; our God is merciful. St. Mark UMC Church Council Meeting Summary January 28, 2024

The Finance Committee met on January 11, 2024 to review the financial position at the close of 2023. Through 4th quarter contributions were \$142,937.54 and expenses were \$145,029.38 for a difference of \$2,091.84; however, the Foundation Account earned \$6,898.24 in interest, so we ended the year \$4,806.40 to the good. The 2024 Stewardship Program has 24 pledge units pledging \$90,500.00.

I The Trustees have completed the 2023 church inventory. The exterior light on the south wall of the scouting area
■ has been replaced. Plans are in the works to clean the parsonage gutters, trim the shrubs, trim the crepe myrtles
■ at the church and paint the sanctuary door.

SPRC met and reviewed a preliminary job description for a Children/Youth ministry worker. This will be discussed more in February. Our mid-week Bible study at Interfaith Ministries began on Wednesday, January 10, 2024 and has been well attended. The target date to begin our Thursday night worship service is March 21, 2024.

The committee voted unanimously to request Pastor Jeff Ponder-Twardy return to St. Mark for the year 2024.

The Lay Leadership Committee: Positions for a music minister and education team still need to be filled.

■ Membership: We have 111 members.

The UMM will have a breakfast meal provided by Reba Yarbrough. (Date TBD). Annual Pancake Breakfast will be April 6, 2024.

■ The UMW: Because of our successful fundraisers in 2023, the UMW was able to donate \$500.00 to each of our
 ■ 11 charities. In December, we packed gift bags and distributed them to members who are unable to attend. We
 ■ enjoyed a wonderful Christmas luncheon at the home of Reba Yarbrough. We have 12 active members and one
 ■ inactive member.

Shepherding Group: There are two shepherding groups.

Worship Committee: Ash Wednesday service, February 14th from 11 to 12:00. Maundy Thursday service March 28th (TBA). We will have a sunrise service.

The Scouts have been busy marching in the Veteran's and Christmas Parade. The held a fundraiser at Chick-fil-A
 in November. Their Christmas party was attended by Santa Claus in December where he passed out the Pinewood
 Derby kits. The Pinewood Derby will be February 10th. Scout Sunday is February 11th.
