

**A Happy Season** 

A Happy Season There were some things I was reminded of on Ash Wednesday, the first day of the season of Lent. First of all, Christian congregations during Lent are "reminded of the mercy and forgiveness proclaimed in the gospel of Jesus Christ and the need we all have to renew our faith" (UM Book of Worship). Secondly, and this is what made me happy, we've entered into a new season.

A change of season, be it in the church or nature or simply in our lives, means a change in what we can expect based on what the new season brings. I've heard too much of Christians entering Lent with an insistence • on sacrifice and sorrow. Yes, our Lord died a sinner's death. No, I'm not moved to hear "Victory in Jesus" during Holy Week. I'm encouraged with • the beginning of a new season, a new set of expectations based on the truth of mercy and forgiveness proclaimed in the gospel of Jesus Christ AND THE RENEWAL OF OUR FAITH.

Yes, the season of Lent commemorates the journey of Jesus to his prophesied death on the cross as an enemy of Rome and a Jewish blasphemer, a wretched sinner and a dangerous revolutionary. His death, however, was our death and the death of all that was created through him (John 1:3). His resurrection, his Easter, is our Easter, and our resurrection into new life through him and he in us (that will be covered in the following season). This new season is meant to renew our faith in the One who died our death, forgave our sin, and told us the truth -• "... your sins are forgiven" (Mark 2:5)

## Freedom Place and the Children's/Youth Ministry Worker. An Update. . .

I want to share with you an update on the planning the Staff-Parish Relations Committee is doing regarding the Thursday night worship service and the hiring of a Childrens/Youth Ministry Worker.

The Thursday night service will be known as *Freedom Place*. It will be a non-traditional worship experience. It will be promoted in the community through the internet as an opportunity for unchurched (those who don't attend church) or de-churched (folks not attending church any longer) to attend a worship service that is easy to enter and attend without having a church-oriented vocabulary or understanding. Just a time for individuals and families to enter freely to hear contemporary worship music, some scripture, a simple message of grace that will inspire faith, invitations to come to other events at St Mark, and to be prayed for at the close of worship. Our first service will be a run through of how future services might be. It will be Thursday, March 21 at 6:30 p.m. Your invited to attend and to invite others you may know. Rev. Delaney Wray Holloway, the pastor of Oxford 1st UMC, will lead the music portion. She's a gifted musician and excited at contributing to this effort.

The plan is to incorporate *Freedom Place* with a new ministry focused on blessing and discipling children and youth on Thursdays, Sundays and other opportunities during the week. We're finalizing plans to post the job opening on internet sites where ministry jobs are found. The funding for this position has been pledged. We're praying the Lord will direct the right person to our church with a Christ-filled passion for children and sufficient experience to provide this church the leadership to lead many children and youth to Christ. Pray with us for God's will to be done.

### **Church Copier**


